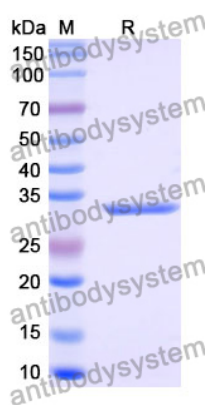
Shipping
