

# Recombinant Human HRG Protein, C-10\*His (Active)

<b>Alternative Names</b>	Histidine-rich glycoprotein, Histidine-proline-rich glycoprotein, HRG, HPRG
<b>Form</b>	Lyophilized
<b>Storage buffer</b>	Lyophilized from a solution in PBS pH 7.4, 5% Trehalose, 5% Mannitol.
<b>Purity</b>	>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE.
<b>Applications</b>	Bioactivity, ELISA, Immunogen, SDS-PAGE, WB
<b>Biological activity</b>	Measured by its ability to support the adhesion of human acute lymphoblastic leukemia cells (MOLT 4). When $1 \times 10^5$ cells/well are added to recombinant human HPRG (Cat #: AHC07501) coated plates, adhesion is induced in a dose-dependent manner in the presence of Concanavalin A. The ED50 for this effect is 0.4-2 µg/mL.
<b>Endotoxin level</b>	<0.1 EU/µg of the protein by the LAL method.
<b>Expression system</b>	Mammalian Cells
<b>Accession</b>	P04196
<b>Protein length</b>	Val19-Lys525
<b>Nature</b>	Recombinant
<b>Stability and Storage</b>	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles. Store at 2 to 8°C for one week. Store at -20 to -80°C for twelve months from the date of receipt.
<b>Reconstitution</b>	Reconstitute in sterile water for a stock solution. A copy of datasheet will be provided with the products, please refer to it for details.
