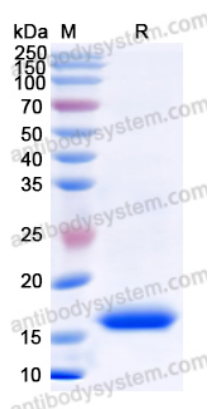
Shipping
